## **Learn more about Air France's A380 in Second Life**

In honor of Air France's first Airbus A380, a space dedicated to the aircraft has been created in the Air France-KLM 'Island in the Sky' Second Life universe.

On November 20, the day of the aircraft's inaugural flight, visitors to this dedicated space as of 2 pm (CET) will have access to photographs, videos, a scale model and a specially-created Freebie.

At the Air France-KLM Island, visitors wishing to learn more about the Group can already access an interactive library containing the Group's most recent financial publications, 3D information on the Air France-KLM stock price, a Corporate Social Responsibility space, a virtual auditorium, a 'lounge' where they can view corporate films, a room with information on the partnership with Alitalia, and the Air France Museum, with scale models and posters from Air France and KLM.
